**“NEWERA - New Expertises for Workers in European Refugees Assistance”**

ERASMUS+ TRAINING PROJECT: YEAR 2017/2018

This Erasmus+ project was born from a partnership between organization and institutions located in Italy, Catalonia, Romania, Germany, Serbia and Great Britain, with specific expertise in training, cooperation and asylum seekers and refugees assistance.

The main purpose of the project is to create a European partnership between public and private organizations to develop and strengthen the professional competences of practitioners working with asylum seekers and refugees.

Specifically, through the exchange of knowledge and good practice between the European partners, the operators (of the organization involved and out of them) will have the opportunities to develop and upgrade their professional skills to manage the reception and the social integration of the asylum seeker and refugee people.

## **MAIN ACTIONS**

The project offers a qualified training course from April 2017 to October 2018, that will be developed through sessions and follow-up on an e-learning platform combined with five short mobility periods of the participants in each of the partner countries.

The four days mobility periods, will serve to get to know the best practices used for the reception of refugees and their integration into the social fabric.

The mobilities are initially planned in June 2017 (Bucharest), October 2017 (Berlin), January 2018 (Barcelona), April 2018 (Belgrade) and July 2018 (Treviso)

In addition, during each mobility, the participants will deal directly on the strengths and weaknesses which characterize every reception system, know the services activated locally and examine in deep some aspects treated during the on-line training course.

## **COSTS**

All costs related to meals and accommodation during the mobilities are fully covered. Participants will be as well reimbursed their travel costs for the mobilities. There is a participation fee of 30€ to be discounted from the travel costs.

## **PARTICIPANTS PROFILE**

The project is aimed to qualified operators (belonging or related as collaborator with the partner organizations) working in direct contact or in favor of asylum seekers and refugees: linguistic and cultural mediators, social workers, educators, psychologists, health workers, etc.
